Explanation of Responses:

- This option was previously reported as covering 35,106 shares at an exercise price of \$25.10 per share, but was adjusted to reflect a 4-for-1 stock split that occurred on March 3, 2015.
- Represents a "net exercise" of outstanding stock options. These shares were withheld by Hanesbrands Inc. for payment of the exercise price and applicable taxes, based on the market price of Hanesbrands Inc. common stock at the time of the option exercise on June 14, 2017 of \$22.90.
- This transaction was executed in multiple trades at prices ranging from \$22.840 to \$22.945. The price reported above reflects the weighted average sale price. The Reporting Person hereby undertakes to provide upon request by the SEC staff, Hanesbrands Inc. or any security holder of Hanesbrands Inc. full information regarding the number of shares sold at each separate price.
- The options vest in three installments of 33% on February 4, 2009, 33% on February 4, 2010 and 34% on February 4, 2011.
